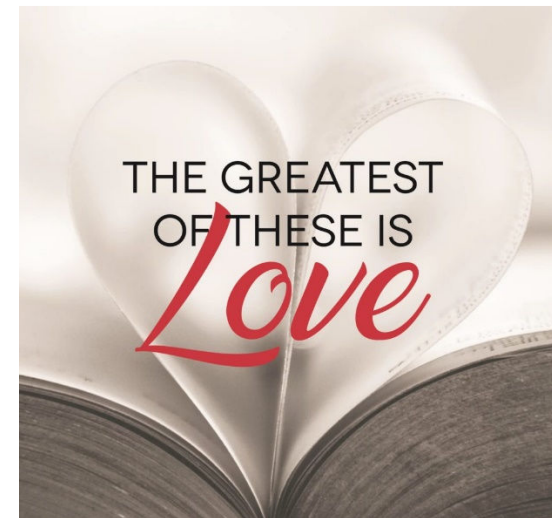

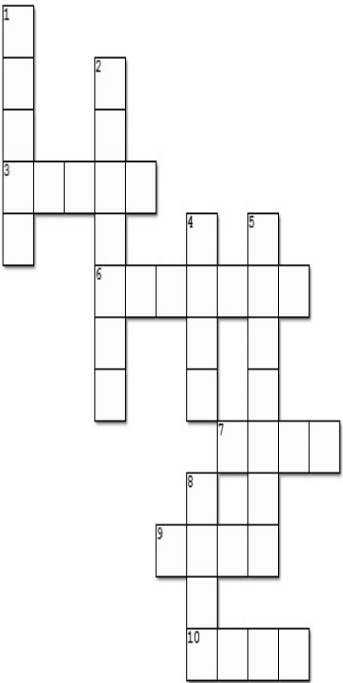
Ish is Hebrew for *male* Adam
